As we gather for the 35th Golf Scramble benefiting Mount Olivet Rolling Acres, we take a moment to remember and honor three people whose vision and generosity helped make this event possible. Terry Hogan, and Roy & Cammie Olson.

Tribute to Terry Hogan

Terry Hogan's connection to Mount Olivet Rolling Acres was rooted in both his love of golf and his deep appreciation for community. Introduced to the game at age 12 while caddying at the Calgary Golf and Country Club, Terry went on to become a lifetime member of the PGA of America and served for 24 years as head golf professional at Town and Country Club in St. Paul.



He was introduced to the Mount Olivet Rolling Acres Golf Scramble by his brother-in-law, Rev. Paul Youngdahl. While Terry enjoyed playing in the tournament, he became best known for the energy and enthusiasm he brought as the event's live auctioneer. Year after year, he helped elevate the Golf Scramble through his presence, generosity, and ability to bring people together in support of a meaningful cause.

Through his involvement, Terry developed a strong appreciation for the mission of Mount Olivet Rolling Acres and the impact it has on individuals and families. He valued being part of a community committed to service and inclusion.

Today, we remember Terry for his generosity, his spirit, and the role he played in growing this event. His contributions continue to be felt in the lives touched by Mount Olivet Rolling Acres, and we are grateful for the legacy he leaves behind.

Tribute to Roy and Cammie Olson

Roy served as a devoted board member of Mount Olivet Rolling Acres for nearly 20 years. His connection to the Mount Olivet community began in the late 1970s when he and Cammie joined Mount Olivet Lutheran Church after their daughter attended Cathedral of the Pines Camp.



In 1987, Roy joined the Mount Olivet Rolling Acres board and soon proposed an idea that would grow into one of the organization's most beloved traditions. A lifelong golfer who once played at Washburn High School and often at Hiawatha Golf Course, Roy believed a golf tournament could bring people together while raising support for the mission.

The first Golf Scramble in 1989 raised \$4,000. Over the years it grew into a remarkable six figure fundraiser and a gathering of friends who care deeply about the people served by Mount Olivet Rolling Acres.

Cammie played an important role as well, serving on the Golf Scramble committee and helping the event flourish. Together, Roy and Cammie believed deeply in the mission and were grateful for the friendships they formed through their involvement.

Married for 70 years, Roy and Cammie passed away just eleven days apart in the fall of 2025.

Today, their legacy lives on in this event and in the lives touched by Mount Olivet Rolling Acres. The entire community remains deeply grateful for their generosity, leadership, and friendship.
